The 22nd annual Excellence in Building Awards for Newcastle were held on Friday 9th September 2016

HBCF generational change

On 3 November the Government announced a significant overhaul of the HBCF that administers home owners warranty.

Some of the notable changes that will come into effect from March 2017 include:

- Broker commissions will be phased out and the broker network will be substantially reduced.
- Premiums will increase in four stages over two years.
- Builder risk will be reflected in pricing. Higher-risk builders will pay higher premiums.
- The government will inject over \$300 million into the HBCF to cover the current deficit.

- It will then move to exit the home warranty market within two years.
- Private insurers may re-enter the market if they meet consumer protection guidelines.
